S.A. HUËT Vouvray Cuvée Constance 2009 This stunning wine is fresh, pure and driven at first, with seamless ginger, creamed fig and glazed pear fruit, before showing its density and power via the core of honeycomb, quince and heather.	98	\$160 500ml
S.A. HUËT Vouvray Moelleux Clos du Bourg Première Trie 2009 Gorgeous, with ginger, orange, clementine, white peach and green fig notes all bouncing off one another, but working harmoniously.	96	\$69
S.A. HUËT Vouvray Moelleux Clos du Bourg Première Trie 2008 Starts with a tangy crème fraîche note before giving way to green almond, green tea, chamomile, powdered ginger and mineral flavors.	95	\$65
DIDIER DAGUENEAU Pouilly-Fumé Silex 2007 Weighty, but lithe and balanced, with alluring honeysuckle, macadamia nut, white asparagus, lemon curd, quinine and straw notes.	94	\$125
GAUTHIER-LHOMME Vouvray Domaine du Viking Cuvée Aurélie 1990 Gorgeous, with sweet dried mango and papaya flavors laced with date, persimmon, ginger powder and green fig marmalade notes.	94	\$80
S.A. HUËT Vouvray Moelleux Le Mont 2009 This wants to be lush, with mango and green fig fruit, but the minerality and ginger blossom and melon rind notes harness it all.	94	\$49
S.A. HUËT Vouvray Moelleux Le Mont Première Trie 2009 A ripe, juicy style, with green almond, fig and pear notes backed by more quince and melon on the rounded, opulent finish.	94	\$69
DIDIER DAGUENEAU Pouilly-Fumé Pur Sang 2007 Shows impressive range and depth, with candied lemon peel and quince hints leading to macadamianut, wet straw and white peach.	93	\$91
GAUTHIER-LHOMME Vouvray Domaine du Viking Cuvée Aurélie 1989 Having shed its opulence, this offers pure apple, melon and persimmon fruit flavors. A lovely contrast to the more powerful 1990.	93	\$80
CHÂTEAU DE LA ROULERIE Coteaux du Layon-Chaume 2009 Plump, juicy and enticing, with a big core of quince, pear and fig fruit laced with notes of ginger and pie crust.	93	\$35
CHÂTEAU DE LA ROULERIE Coteaux du Layon-Chaume Les Aunis 2009 Rounded and lush, but defined and pure, with creamed green melon, fig, glazed pear and papaya character. Very flattering.	93	\$38
